

The Friends of Wesley Lake next fund raising activity is scheduled for November 10, 2015. All are welcome!

Old Business

Gail Rosewater reported on activities dealing with the pond weed. Susan and Gail mentioned that an estimate of \$10,000 will be needed next spring to treat the pond weed. The estimate includes 4 applications of treatment every few weeks starting in mid-March and ending in October.

There are two kind of processes that are available to address the pond weed. They are 1.) chemical application or 2.) harvesting of the pond weed. The treatment which leaves pond residue will require an addition effort to remove the residue.

Joe Woerner estimated the removal cost for the pond weed residue would be between \$10,000 to \$20,000. The activity would include 1.) an access point to get boat in to the lake, 2.) dewatering of the residue, and 3.) the removal of the pond weed residue.

Sharon Davis circulated an article by Tom Washington entitled, "Time to Mow the Lake again." Peter Avakian will discuss with Vito Gadaleta about how the mosquito control activity can help with the pond weed issue. Also, Joe Woerner clarified for the commission why Carp fish cannot be placed in the lake.

Dr. Brandley reviewed the objectives, goals, and purposes of Wesley Lake commission and the commissioner who will lead the effort which were discussed at the last meeting. The following is an update.

Budget:

The commission will create a budget every year and send it to the municipalities. It will include costs for electrical, aerators, and pond weed maintenance. Dr. Brantley and Joe Woerner will be responsible.

Grant Writer:

Joe Woerner will be responsible for this effort.

Pond Weed Control:

Gail Rosewater and Susan Henderson will be responsible.

Bylaws:

Jim Henry will be responsible.

Fund Raising:

Gail Rosewater, Tee Lesinski, and Friends of Wesley will be responsible.

Engineering:

Peter Avakian will be responsible.
