2 Electric Bills	Review of Electric bills. No actual readings of meters. Commission received 2 bills: \$167.90 and \$54.99, for a total of \$122.89. CAQ received no response from utility regarding a credit. Third bill was not received.	Motion to pay the bills by MR Second SR Motion Carried
3	The borough administrator attended the meeting, Kimberly Humphrey. A discussion involving the boro and Biagio Cofone covered the installation of concrete pads for the benches on the Bradley side of the lake.	The boro will be covering the cost, for such installation. Additional discussion regarding the foot bridge repair or replacement. In light of the cost of such actions, the BB administrator will reach out to Neptune Township in order to put in place a joint effect which would allow Neptune and Bradley Beach to share this expense.
4	Discussion on the lowering of the sea grass, as some of its growth exceeded six feet and path that leads to the outflow.	
5	Discussion regarding the outflow pipe to check for debris, plastic and trash cans.	
6	Mr. Lane of Neptune called Mr. Quixley to advise that he has 2 new members that need to be approved as early as next meeting.	
7	Continuing discussion on the problem of the expansive geese population.	
8	Pots and additional flowers.	Motion made MR not to put new pots or more flowers at this time. Second Sal G. Motion Carried.
9	Mr. Quixley advised that he has found a helper that may repaint some of the pavers.	
10	Discussion regarding the height of beach sand at the ocean end of the lake. Biagio Cofone said that the DPW would remove the sand so flowers could be planted next year.	
11	The BB administrator requested a tally as to the number of years Neptune has not paid its annual full amount of \$3,000.	Mr. Quixley stated that he would provide that information.
