

TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE SINE-DIE MEETING - JANUARY 1, 2011

Mayor Jahn called the meeting to order at 11:55 a.m. and requested the Clerk to call the roll. The following members were present: J. Randy Bishop, James W. Manning, Jr., Kevin B. McMillan and Mayor Mary Beth Jahn. Absent: Dr. Michael Brantley

After a moment of Silent Prayer and the Flag Salute, the Mayor asked the Clerk to indicate the fire exits.
