STREET OPENING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

ROAD OPENINGS DISTURBING LESS THAN 90 SF:

Application Fee in the amount of \$50.00 (Twp Code Ch. 13-1.3)

ROAD OPENINGS DISTURBING 90 SF OR GREATER:

- Application Fee in the amount of \$25.00/100 SF or portion thereof (Twp Code Ch. 13-1.3)
- Street Opening Performance Bond in the amount of \$4,000 for a term of five (5) years (Twp Code Ch. 13-1.6) (Original Bonds shall be submitted to the Municipal Clerk)
- Inspection Escrow Fee in the amount of five percent (5%) of the estimated cost of the project, or five hundred (\$500.00) dollars, whichever is greater (Twp Code Ch. 13-1.11)

Application Fee and Inspection Escrow Fee shall be paid in separate checks

EXCAVATION OF NEWLY PAVED STREETS:

No street opening permit shall be issued by the Director of Engineering & Planning which would allow an excavation or opening in paved and improved street surface less than three (3) years old unless the applicant can clearly demonstrate that public health or safety requires that the proposed work be permitted or unless an emergency condition exists.

If determined that the roadway needs to be opened in the event of an emergency the following penalty shall apply.

The penalty charge shall be on a sliding scale determined as follows:

a. Penalty assessment = \$1,000

b. Area of road cut in S.F. x \$5 = Varies

Total a. and b. = Varies

Penalty factor is three (3%) percent of the above total for each unelapsed month or fraction thereof of the three (3) year (36 months) restricted period. Maximum penalty shall be one hundred eight (108%) percent of above total and minimum penalty shall be five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. No portion of the penalty charge shall be refundable and penalty charges do not relieve the permit holder from the required performance cash bond or the required insurance. Restoration of all road openings in "new street" pavement shall be to a "newly paved" condition. The restoration shall be according to subsection 13-1.10.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE:

All applications require submission of a Certificate of Insurance in the minimum amount of \$100,000-\$250,000 for bodily injury, \$25,000 property damage for the purpose of indemnifying the Township of Neptune, in the County of Monmouth, for any personal injuries or property damage, which might be sustained during the work progress. (Twp Code Ch. 13-1.5)
