WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on December 14, 2017 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018 is hereby approved; and

The 2018 Fire District Budget reflects an overall increase of 2.3% in total appropriations versus 2017. The 2018 budget contains an appropriation of \$35,000 in the Supplies line item for the purchase of new self-contained breathing apparatus. This increase is offset by the elimination of a \$35,000 appropriation for new vehicle in 2017. The 2018 budget also includes a mandated increase in the annual pension appropriation and contains a nominal increase in salaries and fire hydrant rental charges.

Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unrestricted Fund Balance(s). The 2018 proposed budget contains a 2.7% increase in the Amount to be Raised by Taxation versus 2017; with a tax rate increase of 1/10 of one cent. The budget proposes a decrease of \$5,000 in the use of unrestricted fund balance versus 2017 due to the estimated results of operations for 2017.

The proposed 2018 budget is \$2,703 below the maximum allowable amount to be raised by taxation as provided by the Property Tax Cap Levy.

A member of the governing body may be both a commissioner and an officer for the purposes of this schedule.
- Compensation: All forms of cash and non-cash payments or benefits provided in exchange for services, including salaries and wages, bonuses, severance payments, deferred payments, retirement benefits, fringe benefits, and other financial arrangements or transactions such as personal vehicles, meals, housing, personal and family education benefits, below-market loans, payment of personal or family travel, entertainment, and personal use of the Fire District's property. Compensation includes payments and other benefits provided to both employees and independent contractors in exchange for services.
- Reportable compensation: The aggregate compensation that is reported (or is required to be reported) on Form W-2, box 1 or 5, whichever amount is greater, and/or Form 1099-MISC, box 7, for the calendar year 2015.
- Other Public Entity: Any municipality, county, local authority, fire district, or other government unit, regardless of whether it is related in any way to the Fire District either by function or by physical location.
