

NEPTUNE TOWNSHIP RENT LEVELING BOARD

Minutes – June 5, 2014

Constance Holmes, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 6:00pm and requested the Secretary to call the roll. The following members were present: James W. Manning, Jr., Morrel Massicot, and Constance Holmes.

Ms. Holmes stated adequate notice of this meeting as required by P.L. Chapter 231 has been provided by notice in the Coaster March 2014, which was posted on the bulletin board of the Municipal Complex and filing a said notice with the Municipal Clerk.

Ms. Holmes announced that the Consumer Price Index [April's Index was 259.985, up 1.6% over the year].

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING – KIM ALSTON

An Administrative hearing was held on behalf of Neptune Venture to appeal the approval of the application for Senior Citizen and Disabled Persons Protection for Kim Alston who resides at 64 Winding Ridge Drive (resident was not present at the hearing). Mr. Anthony gave a brief history surrounding this application. He stated he legally had a problem with the board approving this application and recommended they reverse their prior decision.
