#### BEWARE OF SCAMS - PROTECT YOURSELF!

Scammers target anyone regardless of age, gender, or income level. They use many tactics to show they are "genuine". Scams cost people a lot of money along with a great deal of stress. Recent scams have included people claiming to be from JCP&L or the IRS; or, the caller, or recording, will say it is urgent to speak to you about your credit card or account. There are scams by phone and on-line so never give out personal info, do not return calls to strange numbers and do not open emails that you do not know. Protect yourself.

#### TAX COUNSELORS NEEDED FOR SENIOR TAX PREPARATION

If you have ever completed your own tax return and/or have basic accounting and computer skills, why not volunteer to help Seniors prepare their 2015 tax returns at our Center. #### SOCIAL WORKER AVAILABLE MONTHLY AT OUR CENTER


If you need assistance from a Licensed Social Worker, Prem Singh, from the Monmouth County Division of Social Services, is available at our Center monthly. Prem has her masters degree and provides counseling in addition to assisting with information about Medicaid, financial assistance, food stamps, homecare, etc. Appointments are available by appointment on the 2nd Tuesday of each month from 10-12noon. #### LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is designed to help low-income households and/or individuals, 60 years of age or older, meet heating and medically necessary cooling costs.
