#### ORDINANCE NO. 11-26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE, THE BOROUGH OF TINTON FALLS, MICHAEL & JENNIFER SULLIVAN, AND THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE SEWERAGE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SANITARY SEWERAGE SERVICE TO A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING AT 1961 JUMPING BROOK ROAD, IN THE BOROUGH OF TINTON FALLS

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 authorizes the Township of Neptune to enter into a contract with another "local unit" as defined therein; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of Tinton Falls is a local unit within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1, et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, Michael and Jennifer Sullivan (" the Sullivans") own lands located in the Borough of Tinton Falls on which a single family residential dwelling is located and maintained; and,

WHEREAS, the dwelling owned by the Sullivans which is located within the Borough of Tinton Falls was provided with an on-site sanitary sewage disposal system that is now failing and therefore constitutes a health hazard; and,

WHEREAS, at the present time no sewer facilities exist at the facilities operated by the Sullivans and within the Borough of Tinton Falls, but a Township owned sewer line does exist directly in front of the property on Jumping Brook Road; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Neptune has agreed to permit the sewage flow from the Sullivans to pass through its sanitary sewer system for treatment by Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of Tinton Falls and the Township of Neptune have entered into sewer service agreements with the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority whose consent to the

proposal by both municipalities is sought.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Neptune, County of Monmouth, New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a Service Agreement with the Borough of Tinton Falls, Michael and Jennifer Sullivan and the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority to provide sewer service to the Sullivans, at 1961 Jumping Brook Road, through the facilities of the Township of Neptune and with the consent of the Township of Neptune Sewerage Authority in accordance with the terms of the agreement which is annexed hereto and which shall be on file for public inspection in the Office of the Neptune Township Municipal Clerk.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is contingent upon there being adequate funds available in accordance with the connection fees and annual service charges as described in the agreement.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is further contingent upon the execution of said agreement by all parties. If necessary, this section may be amended from time to time by ordinance of the Township Committee of the Township of Neptune.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and final publication as provided by law.
