WHEREAS, the Towns hip Committee also authorized leg al fees in the amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 towards the condemnation proceedings; and

WHEREAS, as a result of a hearing before Court appointed Commissioners on August 23, 2011 the Commissioners issue d a report indicating that they reviewed the appraisal and testimony of witnesses at the aforesaid hearing and found, without stating reasons, that the market value of the subject property was \$240,000.00 rather than the \$215,000.00 set forth in the Township appraisal of August 12, 2010; and

WHEREAS, it is still in the best interest for the T ownship of Neptune to obtain title to the aforesaid property and to use the same for public purpo ses at the aforesaid additional cost of \$25,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED that the Mayor an d the Township Committee of the Township of Neptune, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, hereby authorizes the additional payment of \$25,000.00 ad ded to the \$215,000.00 authorized by Ordinance No. 11-07 for the acq uisition of 1700 West Lake Avenue, Neptune, New Jersey, also known as Block 217, Lot 58-61 as part of condemnation proceedings previously authorized and commenced by the Municipal Attorney, Gene J. Anthony, Esq.; and
