- 3. Report from Recreation Director—Dawn shared recreation information concerning:
  - Welcome to first time meeting attendees—Eric Houghtaling, Maureen Ruotolo, Charles (Chappy)
    Williams, and Laria Hamilton. Dawn will send a list of interested potential members for the Rec Committee to the Township Committee for consideration /approval.
  - Dawn gave an overview of the **Recreation Events & Calendar**, summer events & camp listings as well as an update on Summer Rec for 2011.
