AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VOLUME I, CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE BY ADDING HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONES ON BENSON AVENUE AND EMBURY AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Neptune that the Code of the Township of Neptune is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1

Volume I, Chapter VII, Section 7-21.2 - Handicapped Parking Spaces on Public Roads - Locations Designated, is hereby amended by adding the following:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>No. of Spaces</u>	<u>Location</u>
Benson Avenue	1	East side of Benson Avenue beginning 25 feet south of the southeast intersection of Mt. Hermon Way and Benson Avenue.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>No. of Spaces</u>	<u>Location</u>
Embury Avenue	1	North side of Embury Avenue beginning 25 feet west of the northwest intersection of New York Avenue and Embury Avenue.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in accordance with law.

ORDINANCE NO. 09-16

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #05-45 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING JOB TITLES AND SETTING THE SALARY RANGES FOR SAID JOB TITLES AND FOR EXISTING JOB TITLES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND REPEALING ALL PARTS OF PREVIOUS ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH." BY CREATING THE POSITION OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION SECRETARY

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, as follows:

Section 1. The Township Committee of the Township of Neptune hereby creates the job title of Historic Preservation Commission Secretary.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 05-45 be and is hereby amended to add the salary range of said position as follows:
